Helicopters are extremely manoeuvrable and can land and take off vertically. They therefore don't need a take-off/landing strip.



In 1907, Paul Cornu was one of the first to fly a helicopter. He managed to lift 150 cm from the ground, that is, about the height of seven soccer balls.



Certain helicopters, like the Chinook, have two horizontal engines that rotate in opposite directions, which enables the helicopter to lift heavy objects.
